COMPLAINT

The Complainant, being duly sworn, makes complaint to the above-named Court and states that there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant committed the following offense(s). The complainant states that the following facts establish PROBABLE CAUSE:

Your complainant, Detective Kim Jones-O'Brien, is an investigator with the Bloomington Police Department. In that capacity, she has investigated the facts and circumstances of the offenses alleged herein by reviewing reports prepared by other officers and by conducting personal investigation including interviewing **RANDY LEE RONNING**, the defendant named herein.

Your complainant has learned that on 4/4/09, Bloomington Police Officers were called to the Days Inn in Bloomington, Hennepin County, Minnesota. A known adult female reported that she had been staying in the same room with the defendant and two children. She woke up at approximately 4:00 a.m. and observed the defendant rubbing the vaginal area of Victim A, born 8/12/99 over her clothing. The witness stated that Victim A moved, apparently waking up and the witness observed the defendant return to his bed briefly. A few minutes later, he came back to the bed Victim A was sleeping in and again began to rub her vaginal area over the clothing. The witness waited for the defendant to return to his bed. She then slipped into an adjoining room and called the police.

Police took Victim A to Children's Hospital for an examination. A Midwest Children's Resource Center Nurse interviewed her in preparation for the medical exam. She stated that she went to the Day's Inn with her friend, Victim B. She stated that while there, the defendant was babysitting her overnight. She stated that everyone was sleeping. Initially an adult woman was sleeping on the same bed but she got up and went into the other room. She stated that at approximately 3:30 a.m., she woke up because the defendant was pulling down her pants and touching her butt with his hands. She felt the defendant spread her cheeks apart. She stated that he touched her with something that she did not think was a hand. She stated it felt more like his penis. She felt what she described as a couple of "drips of water" when he did this. The defendant briefly got up and went to the bathroom. Victim A sat up and was crying when the defendant returned. The police arrived shortly after Victim A sat up.

Victim B, date of birth 10/30/1998, was interviewed at CornerHouse. She stated that she didn't know if anything happened to her that night because she was sleeping. She stated that the defendant had been her babysitter since she was approximately two years old. She stated that when she was about eight years old, the defendant began to touch her in inappropriate ways. He took her to the same hotel in Bloomington and got on top of her while she was sleeping. She also stated that he would kiss her on the cheeks or lips. This sexual contact made her feel scared and confused. On multiple occasions, he would put his hand underneath her underwear and rub her buttocks. On one occasion, he was rubbing her buttocks under her underwear. He spread her cheeks apart and put his finger in the opening of her anus. This also happened at the Days Inn in Bloomington.

Your complainant interviewed the defendant after a Miranda advisory. The defendant admitted that he had touched Victim A underneath her underwear and admitted rubbing her buttocks. He also stated that he inserted a portion of his thumb into her anus. Your complainant also admitted multiple sexual contacts with Victim B. These contacts occurred in Bloomington and Burnsville. The defendant admitted that on one occasion, he penetrated her anus with his thumb.

The defendant is presently in custody.

That on or between 1/1/07 and 4/4/09 in Blooming in Hennepin County, Minnesota, **RANDY LEE RONNING** , born 5/11/72 engaged in sexual penetration with Victim B, born 10/30/1998 a person under the age of thirteen years, and more than thirty-six months younger than **RANDY LEE RONNING** .

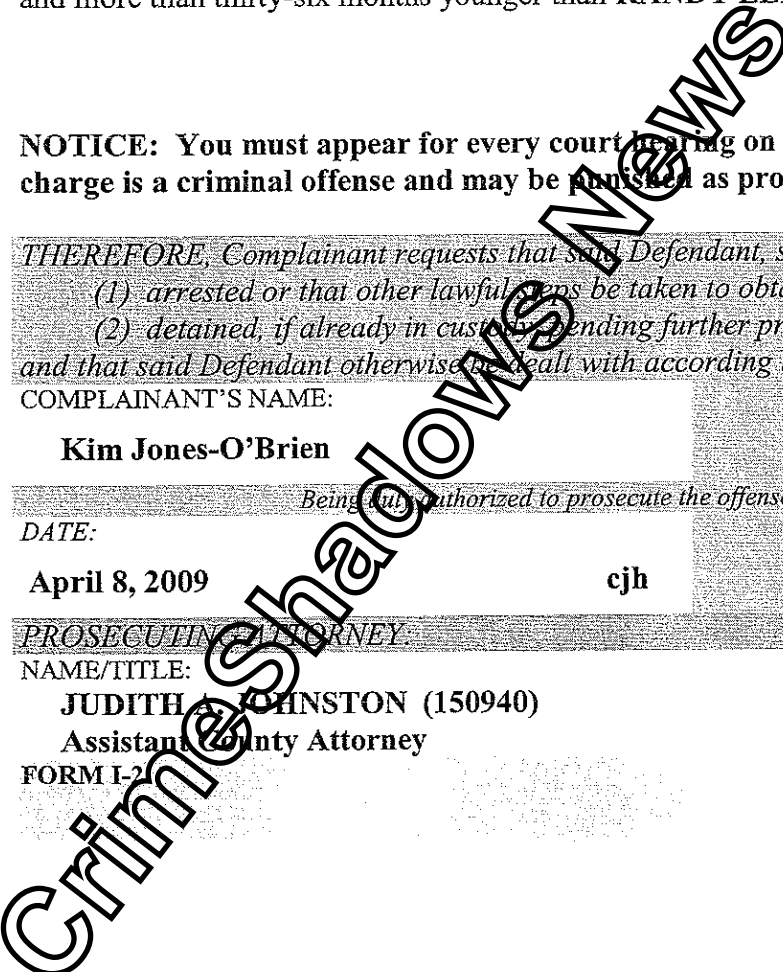
